GOODS FOR GOOD PACKING AND SORTING VENUE

GOODS FOR GOOD WATFORD OFFICE:

Able to manage 6/7 staff members to do a one-day session packing/sorting goods and preparing orders for charity partners.

NORTHAMPTON AID HUB:

Northampton partner (just 5 minutes off M1) – My 1st Years – able to manage 20 staff members to support warehousing and logistics team in packing/sorting and putting together orders. Tour of facility.

IN-HOUSE SESSION

At a venue of your choice, set-up a special collection event for your team and organise sorting/packing. This has often been done as team building sessions and can take around 2/2.5 hours. We will provide all boxes/sacks, tape labels etc.

OVERSEAS FRONT-LINE EXPERIENCE

To visit overseas charity partners 2 night/3-day trip, e.g., to Poland or Moldova with a first-hand experience of how refugees and people in poverty are supported in these countries. This may or may not include distribution of goods to beneficiaries.
